DOCUMENTS TO BRING TO YOUR ENROLLMENT APPOINTMENT AT COOPER GREEN

Cooper Green Mercy Health Service Authority's Health First Program funds health care services to residents of Jefferson County who are uninsured, under insured, or have no means to pay for health care.

To qualify, potential patients must be at least 18 years of age, a resident of Alabama for at least 1 year, and a resident of Jefferson County for at least 30 days.

Interested patients can call 205-930-3350 to set up their enrollment appointment. After scheduling an appointment, potential patients are required to bring the following documents to their Health First Enrollment Appointment.

- Current insurance card (if applicable)
- Current Alabama issued ID
- Social Security card
- Proof of 1 year Alabama residency
- 30-day official mail (no personal mail)
- Proof of household income (check stubs, tax transcripts, etc.)
- SSI or SSDI current award letter
- Pension/retirement income
- Proof of current SNAP notice of action letter (if applicable)
- Proof of dependent children (birth certificates)
- · No letters of support will be accepted
